She extended her greetings on Krishnastami and thanked all the parents for sparing their valuable time on the festive day to attend the meeting. She introduced Dr Suresh Sajjan-Principal, Dr A.V. RamaRaju- Vice Principal, Dr Sudhakara Reddy - Associate Dean (Academics), Dr Padma Priya C.V-Associate Dean(Student support services) and the teaching faculty of first year BDS to the parents. The agenda of the meeting was to discuss the overall development of the students.
- Dr. Suresh Sajjan welcomed all the parents for the meeting and explained that NTR University is recording the students biometric attendance and those students who doesn't have the minimum of 75% attendance in each subject theory and practical separately will not be eligible for giving examinations. So parents should motivate their children not to miss any classes or practicals. It was informed that from this September onwards, recording of attendance by college in DCAP will be stopped, which means there will not be any messages for the parents regarding the absence of the ward. Students were given ID and password and they can check their University biometric attendance whenever required. Monthly attendance recorded in University Biometric equipment will be displayed in the notice boards. Parents can put a mail to principal@vdc.edu.in with their students name requesting for attendance particulars and the internal marks report will be sent in the reply mail. This would help the parents to monitor their ward progress as and when required by sending a request mail.
- Dr Sudhakara Reddy, Associate Dean for Academics reiterated regarding the NTRUHS biometric attendance and said the details of the email ID for which communication will be sent in the parents WhatsApp group too.
- Parents were requested to interact with the teachers regarding their children progress and also suggestions, queries or opinions are welcomed.
- Mother of N Sowmya, appreciated the initiative taken by the college to organise the Parent-Teacher Meeting online. She acknowledged the hard work put in by the faculty and are confident that her daughter will do her exam well with their support. They are happy to have joined their child in the institute. She said that her daughter is having difficulty in understanding DA & DH subject and teeth carving. Dr Ravikanth responded saying that they understood that some students apart from their daughter are facing this issue after their poor performance in the recent internal examinations, so they have stopped the regular classes and started revising the topics which was found difficult by students. Regarding the carving difficulty faced by her daughter, Dr Suresh Sajjan said that all may not have similar hand skills, but dentistry requires both motor skills and knowledge and she should practice to acquire these skills and faculty will be available to give suggestions for the improvement.

- Ms Sireesha parent of B.Lohitha, said her daughter is happy with the teaching and learning process in the college, but she has difficulty in reproducing whatever she learnt. Dr Suresh Sajjan responded saying that there is difference in the professional course, they have to learn with reasoning and understand through practical experience unlike in the intermediate course where they are spoon fed. The students who were used to that methodology will take time to transition, so as parents provide motivation and support them during the process.
- Mr Sitharamraju parent of Bhavana Shyamala said he is proud to be associated with Vishnu and wanted to know the performance of their child. He suggested that it would be better if there is a day gap between the internal exams as their daughter and friends found difficulty in managing the reading time for the exams. Dr Vidya, replied saying that the final internal exam will be in the same pattern as the university exam with a day gap between each exam, but the first and second internal examinations will be without day break as the syllabus for the exams is less and if there is a gap between the exams, students will skip the theory or practical sessions on those days.
- Aruna Satish parent of Ysaswi complained that their child complains of lot of written work and is finding difficulty in managing time for the reading work. Dr Suresh Sajjan responded that they would enquire with all the subjects incharge's and act accordingly.
- Father of Sai Keerthana said there are no complaints from his child side and she is happy with the college and faculty and enquired about the performance of their daughter. Dr Vidya, Dr Ravikanth, Dr Swathi, Dr Vinod said that she is doing well in their respective subjects with good attendance and she is active in the college.
- Mother of D Bhavana, Brother of M Prasanna, Father of G.Pranathi, Mother of Snigdha, enquired regarding their children attendance and progress. Inputs regarding these details for each subject were given by the corresponding faculty. Dr Suresh Sajjan suggested the parents to bring to the notice any specific issues and the attendance and internal marks details for their ward can be obtained by sending mail to principal@vdc.edu.in.
- Uncle of Sai Sathvik said that he is happy with his nephew studying in a prestigious college and his only complaint was memorising anatomy and as a doctor himself he suggested it would be better if they were taught with skull and bones. Dr Vidya responded that they teach osteology with bones chair side for the students and they have any time access to them and they are going to start dissection from next week. Students are always taught with practical exposure and there is no need to worry regarding this.
- Parent of Vaishnavi complained that her daughter biometric attendance is not recorded for a period of time and they are worried regarding this. Dr Vidya replied that Vaishnavi had issues recording biometric attendance previously but now it is rectified. Regarding the period during which the attendance was not recorded, college has sent a mail to NTR University and are awaiting for the reply. College is aware about the issue and they would see to that the issue is resolved.
- Father of M Roshini brought to the notice of faculty that her child has difficulty in communication and she is facing problem answering the viva and requested to provide some guidance to her regarding this. Dr Padma Priya replied that faculty will surely support her and asked her to interact with her friends and seniors and there is a psychologist available in the

campus who would personally help the students when approached. As a parent don't stress her but provide encouragement to her.

- Father of Nagalakshmi said that her daughter is tensed regarding the research project work and is worried whether she can do the work. Dr Suresh Sajjan said that there is faculty as a guide for the research project and they would deliberate the tasks which the student is capable of without effecting her academic work.
- Dr Padma Priya introduced the campus psychologist, Dr Bhavani Prakash who is also present in the online meeting and requested her to interact with the parents. Dr Bhavani, greeted the parents and said that she conducts bi monthly life skill classes and gives motivational and life skill inputs for them as students pursuing professional courses. She does person to person interaction to understand their emotional strengths and weaknesses. She suggested that parents also should support their children and if there are any fears parents should provide that freedom and approachability to convey them.
- Dr Suresh Sajjan thanked all the parents for actively interacting in this online meeting and said that faculty will always be there to guide them and direct them at all the levels. Students have to interact with the teachers and students have to tune their communication skills.

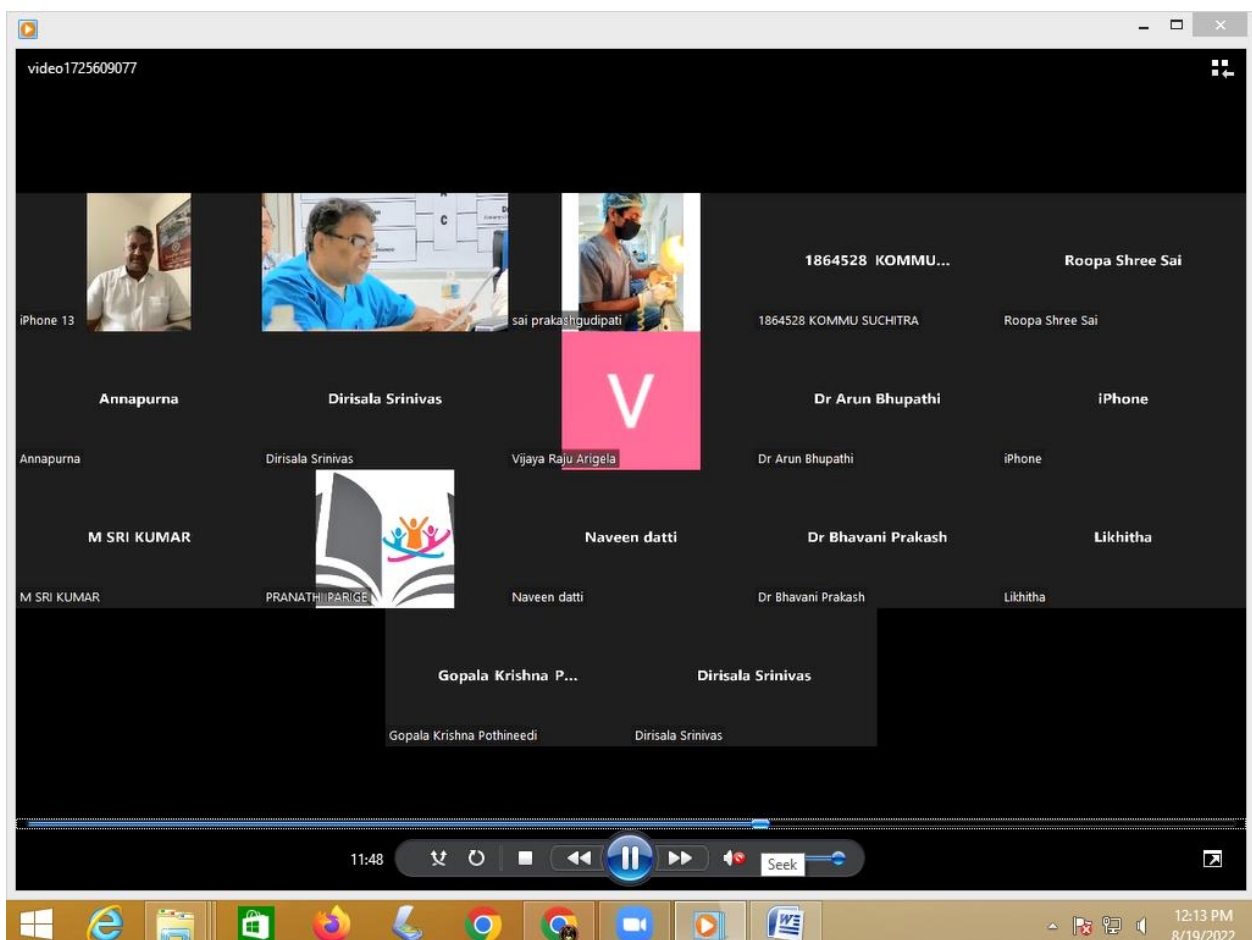
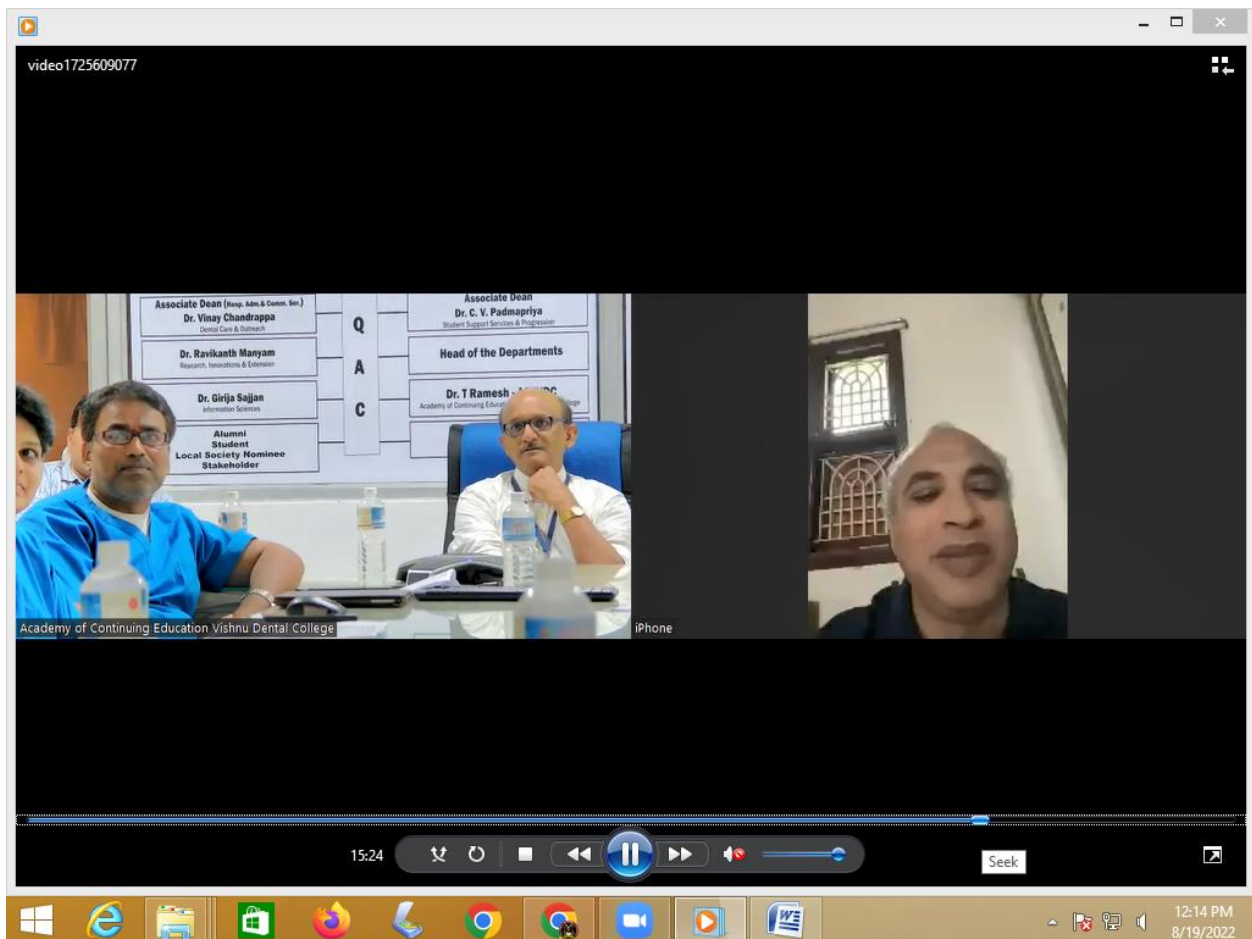

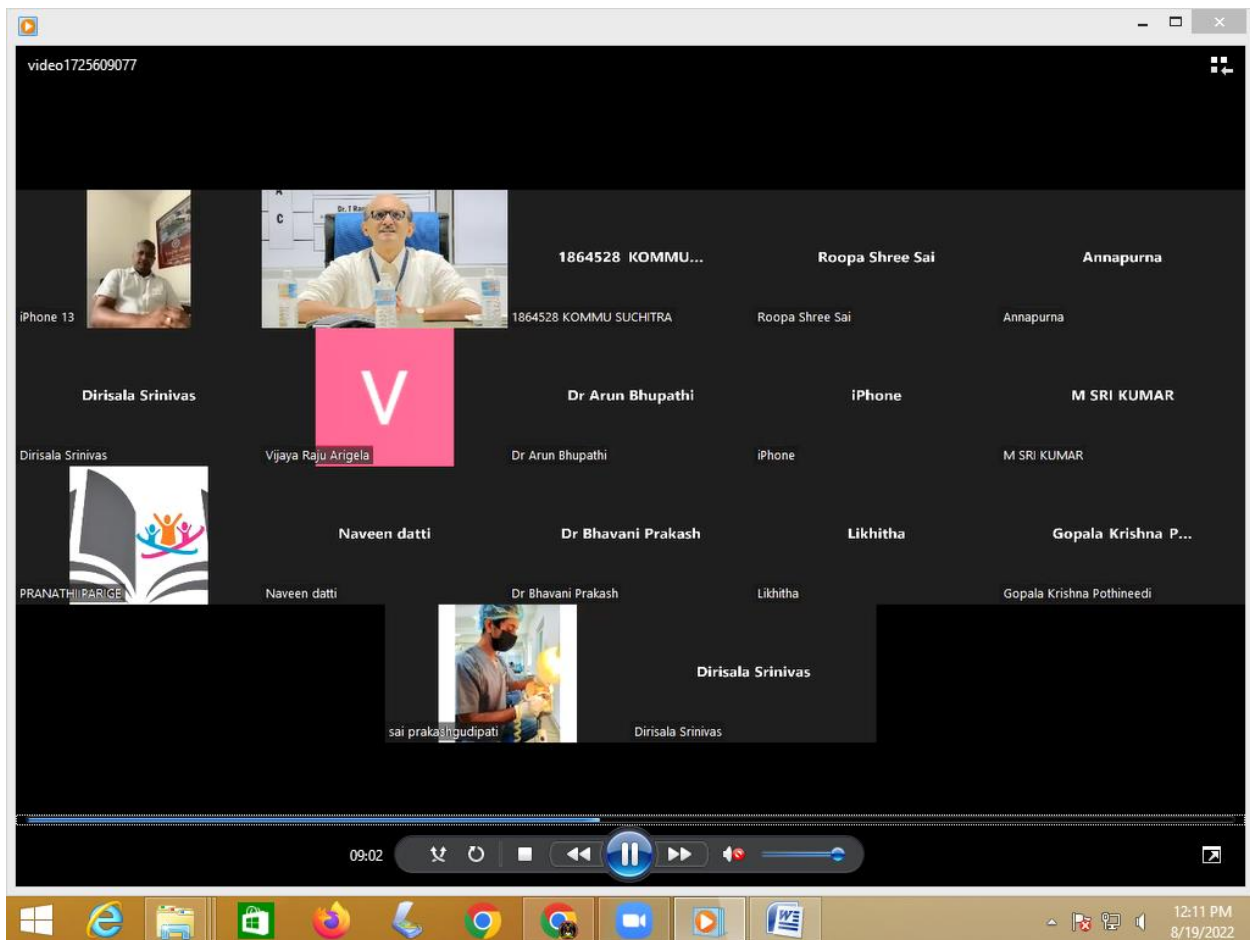
Minutes of Parent-Teacher Meeting (Online) for III & IV BDS students

motivate the patients for the procedures. There are number of students who are finishing the quota and sometimes doing more than the quota. She said to counsel their daughter and she would also interact with her and motivate her for a plan of action. Dr Shivaji, faculty of Oral surgery said that the extraction quota is mandatory so that students get exposed to different case scenarios and gain confidence when they actually go for their individual clinical practice. He also mentioned that students who have done less number of cases are being planned for community treatment camps as the scope for extractions is more during the camps.

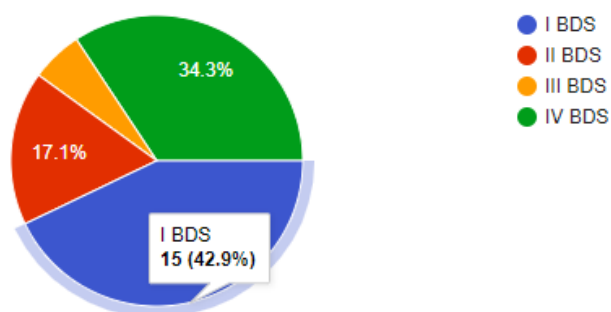

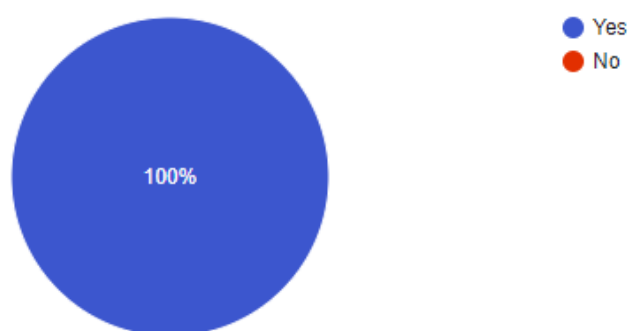
Year of study

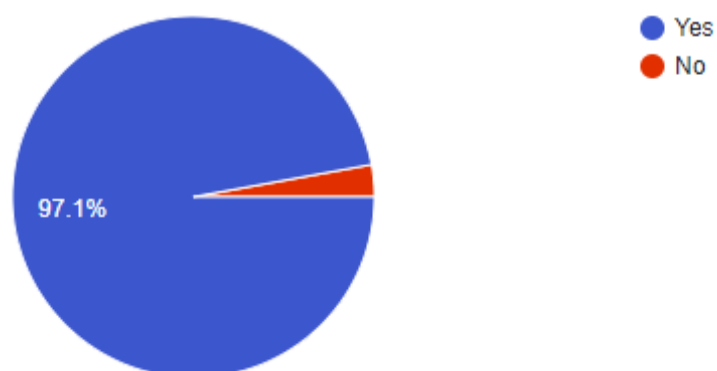
Were you comfortable to interact with teachers?

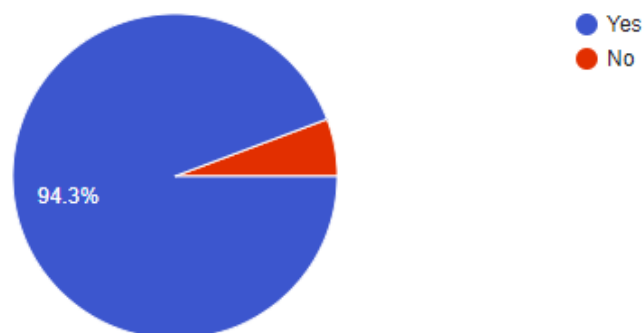
Were the teachers approachable and open to the parental input?

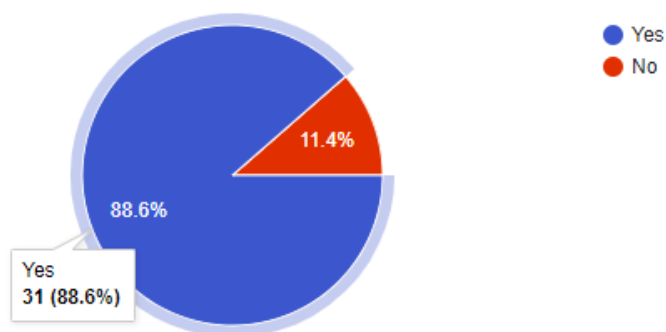
Do you feel your ward is properly engaged in the academic activities ?

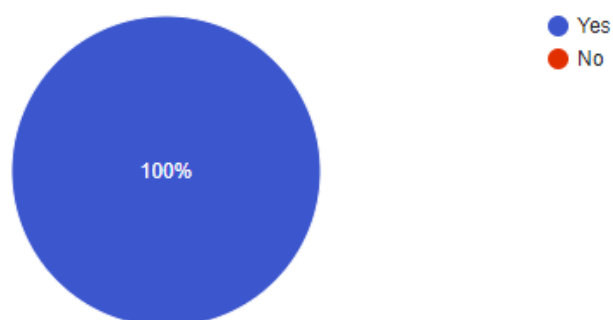
Are you satisfied with your ward practical exposure ?
