2.1 Purpose

This policy lays out what scholarly activity is allowed and avoids plagiarism, self-plagiarism, and improper use of intellectual property in all academic activities conducted at this institution.

2.2 Policy statement

Students, faculty members, researchers, and all collaborating entities will ensure that the content written and presented is authentic. Any borrowing of ideas, words, figures, tables, computer codes, and data from other authors must be properly cited.

2.3 Requirements

All thesis, dissertations, manuscript, presentations, and projects should undergo an assessment through approved similarity software. Authors will properly reference all sources and seek permission for any copyrighted material used.

2.4 Obligations

Students are responsible for submitting original work. Supervisors are responsible for assessing originality and for ensuring proper citations. Departments are responsible for promoting awareness of plagiarism.

2.5 Consequences

Plagiarism detected through excessive similarity or other methods can result in the submission being revised or rejected, as well as other penalties.
